The ratio of apples to oranges is 2:5. If there are 48 apples in the basket, how many oranges are there?

Jane sells oranges. Each orange costs \$2.5. Write an equation that represents how much she makes in a day. Find out how much she makes if she sells 12, 15, 25, and 30 oranges. Label your dependent and independent variables. Graph.
